



INFORMATION REPORT FOR A PERSON

BROKEN UP INTO SECTIONS, JUST FOLLOW EACH HEADING AND CREATE YOUR OWN

TITLE

- ▶ Your title should be interesting but also make sense.
- ▶ It does not need to have just the person's name as the heading!

INTRODUCTION

- ▶ Who are they?
- ▶ What are they known for?
- ▶ Introduce the person with small but interesting facts to hook the reader

SUBHEADING- BACKGROUND

- ▶ Where are they from?
- ▶ How did they become famous?
- ▶ Tell about them before they were famous too

SUBHEADING- EARLY YEARS

- ▶ Explain how they first started/got going in their early career
- ▶ What got them started on their path? Where they inspired? Did they see someone do something amazing? Did something bad/hard happen that they wanted to change?

SUBHEADING-GREATEST ACHIEVEMENT

- ▶ What are they most known for?
- ▶ How has it affected/changed their life?
- ▶ Why is the achievement so important?

SUBHEADING-OTHER ACHIEVEMENTS

- ▶ What other things have they done that stand out?
- ▶ Where there any failures?
- ▶ What other things have they done?
- ▶ What impact has it had on them?

SUBHEADING- FAMILY

- ▶ What do you know about their family situation?
- ▶ Tell about them and how they keep in contact with them or why they cannot/don't

SUBHEADING- HOBBIES

- ▶ What do they do for fun?
- ▶ What things are they good at besides what they are famous for?

CONCLUSION

- ▶ Restate the main parts of your information report in a different way (don't just copy chunks of your report)
- ▶ This paragraph should summarise your report

DECORATION

- ▶ Make sure to add images into your report. You can pick images to go with each subheading or do a few at the beginning or the end
- ▶ Remember to label your picture with words
- ▶ Remember to REVISE and EDIT your writing for spelling, punctuation, makes sense and organising your headings in an order that makes sense
